

# CIT 235 Web Site Development Agreement

1. The web site will be developed by students with no guarantee that the site will be developed at the level that an experienced, professional developer may be capable of producing. However, every effort will be made to insure that the site is both functional and built according to current development standards.
2. The site will be created and delivered at the end of the current semester; semesters end in December, April and July. The site, once delivered, will not be maintained by the development team or other students or employees of Brigham Young University-Idaho. The client will be responsible for maintaining the finished site or hiring someone to maintain it for them.
3. The web site will be a static web site providing no database interactivity nor application capability unless arranged for in advance. If a database and interactivity are agreed upon, the database will be MySQL and the scripting language shall be PHP. The site owner must provide hosting at the beginning of the development process that supports these specifications and provide the student development team appropriate access to the site so that the site can be developed.
4. The students and client must work together to populate the web site with content. It is primarily the client's responsibility to provide the content of the site. Ongoing communications between the development team and client must be prompt in order for the site to be completed on time.
5. The students will produce the web site as a class project and will not be paid for their services.
6. The students, employees of BYU-Idaho nor the university will be liable or responsible for the finished product.
7. The client will be solely responsible for providing a host for the web site.
8. The web site will be presented to other student development teams near the end of the semester and the client will be invited to attend the presentation. The development team will be responsible for informing the client of the date, time and location of the presentation.
9. The client will be invited to provide feedback to the professor concerning the finished web site and the development process in an effort to better the process for future clients and students.
